op Tips for Raising Money



We hope this encourages and inspires you to hit your targets and more so!

Top Tip No.1 Tell your story! Whether it is via social media, blogging, etc let people know your journey and always leave your sponsor page link for people to sponsor you

Top Tip No.2 Hold a Quiz night, we can help you with this, gather friends and family and host in your local pub, restaurant or hall, sit back and see how competitive it gets!

Top Tip No.3 If you work in an office or place of more than ten people, get them to do a collection on your behalf. To make it even more fun, have a dress down day or fancy dress day!

Top Tip No.4 Hold a bake sale! If your baking isn't that great, get friends and family to bake on behalf of you and you can do the selling at local schools or coffee mornings

Top Tip No.5 Set up a Sponsor Page, More information in this pack, but by having a sponsor page online, it is easier for you to hit your target by sharing at least once a week

Sase Study - A Fundraisers Journey

"Please read how one of our supporters challenged herself by climbing the Three Peaks in Wales, and achieved above her target sponsorship".



I set up a fundraising page via Virgin Money Giving which I shared at least once a week to begin with to get people noticing this huge challenge! As the event got closer, I tried to add little snippets of my training and reasons for doing the challenge so that people knew where their money would be going.

A month before the event, I boosted my total by hosting a pub quiz and gathered friends and family to take part. This was a great idea as some people hadn't sponsored me yet but having a quiz with a raffle certainly made my total become higher!

As I climbed each mountain, I updated my Facebook status to let everyone know how it was going and over the three days, I hit my target and even more so!

I kept my sponsor page open for another month. I would always say keep talking about your challenge, any training you are doing and any events you are putting on to keep people interested and remain in their minds around pay day!...


"Mitchell's Miracles rely solely on public funding so any amounts raised go straight towards helping families affected by Neuroblastoma".

How does my fundraising help?

The news that a child has been diagnosed with Neuroblastoma (childhood cancer) is difficult enough to comprehend, without the situation being made worse with the financial worries. We understand that parents / guardian's often need to leave employment to provide the necessary care their poorly child needs, and although they are entitled to the same state benefits as other non-working parents, outgoings can soar dramatically and can leave many families in dire straits.





Did you know that you can set up a Facebook fundraiser for your challenge?

Any type of online fundraising starts with the incorporation of social media. Facebook has millions of users worldwide, which makes it the perfect place to raise awareness about your fundraiser.

Create An Engaging Facebook announcement about your challenge. For example, if your doing a tandem skydive, then you will want to avoid using a short one line status update such as "I'm doing a skydive, Please donate here", as most people will simply scroll past it.

If you go with a status update that provides more detail, Example: Hello friends and family, as you may or may not know, I have decided to take part in a charity challenge of a lifetime and will be skydiving 13,000 ft. Please help me to achieve my target amount of £....

People will be more engaged by an inspiring status, and are more likely to make a donation.

Another great way to fundraise is a Facebook Live broadcast. Facebook Live will attract more traffic to your fundraiser than any other type of content you will post.

How to set up a Facebook fundraiser



Search for Mitchell's Miracles Facebook page. Click fundraiser, as seen on image above.



Click "Raise Money"



Set up your page, inform your friends & family about your challenge
